SHIRAZ - 2014

HARVEST

A small parcel of carefully selected shiraz fruit was harvested from our Glendon vineyard in Padthaway on the 12th March 2014.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation was in small 8 tonne open-topped fermenters, with 23% of the ferment included as whole bunches, including stalks. This was to add interest and linearity. Maturation was for 17 months, in new (30%) Francois Freres hand select hogsheads and seasoned oak from Seguin Moreau cooperages. Bottling was in December 2015.

CHARACTER

Deep red in colour, the nose rich with spicy blackberry fruit, notes of liquorice and the perfumed and slight stalky note from the whole bunches. The palate is plush and dense with layers of fruit and spice interwoven with coffee-vanilla oak, leading to a fine grained sticky tannin finish. An elegant expression of Padthaway Shiraz.
